Turon University was established in 2022 in the city of Qarshi for the purpose of training highly qualified and competitive personnel. Currently, the University intends to train specialists in 35 fields of study.

Education at the university is carried out by leading professors and teachers in classrooms equipped with modern technologies. The university has lecture and practical rooms, computer laboratories, an information resource center and an electronic library equipped with modern computers.

A wi-fi internet network fully covers the university building, and students are provided with free access.

The university offers 22 bachelor's and 10 master's programs, with instruction available in Uzbek, Russian, and English. Fields of study include international relations, economics, pedagogy, medicine, and multiple language specializations such as Chinese, Turkish, English, Arabic, and Korean.

Committed to providing quality education aligned with international standards, Turon University employs leading professors who utilize modern technologies and innovative teaching methods. The campus is equipped with contemporary lecture halls, practical rooms, computer laboratories, and an electronic library.

Turon University maintains partnerships with over 100 universities across 20 countries, facilitating various international programs and attracting foreign students. Notably, the university collaborates with the University of Chemistry and Technology (UCT) in Prague, Czech Republic, offering a joint program in Economics and Management.

ABOUT QARSHI CITY



Qarshi is a city in southern Uzbekistan. It is the capital of Qashqadaryo Region. Administratively, Qarshi is a district-level city, that includes the urban-type settlement Qashqadaryo. It has a population of 278,300 (2021 estimate). It is about 520 km south-southwest of Tashkent, and about 273 km north of Termez. The city is important in natural gasproduction, but Qarshi is also famous for its production of woven flat carpets.

MAIN SITES

Qarshi, which keeps preserving its historical and cultural traditions, remains attractive to many scientists and history enthusiasts.

- The main square of the city, Mustakillik Square, hosts massive architectural constructions, administrative buildings, fountains, and the "El-yurt tayanchi" monument (Support of Motherland).
- The seven-arched bridge over the Kashkadarya River is one of those unique historic attractions.
- Sardoba is another interesting construction that was used for keeping water in this dry region.



• QARSHI BRIDGE

Qarshi Bridge is an ancient brick bridge built over the Qashqadaryo River, constructed in the second half of the 16th century.



• WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL

Qarshi's war memorial to casualties of the Great Patriotic War is one of the largest Soviet era memorials in Central Asia. It is a mix of walkways, plaques, an eternal flame, and a red star-topped tower with a series of stained-glass windows. It is possible to access the upper levels of the memorial on request.

• ODINA MOSQUE

Odina Mosque was built in the 16th century and is on the southeast side of Qarshi's Eski Bazaar. The mosque was built on the site of an older Mongol palace, which had also been used as a prison.



CLIMATE OF QARSHI

- In Qarshi, the summers are sweltering, arid, and clear and the winters are very cold, snowy, and partly cloudy. Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from 29°F to 100°F and is rarely below 17°F or above 106°F.
- **The hot season** lasts for 3.7 months, from May 23 to September 12, with an average daily high temperature above 89°F. The hottest month of the year in Qarshi is **July**, with an average high of 100°F and low of 71°F.
- **The cold season** lasts for 3.4 months, from November 24 to March 5, with an average daily high temperature below 57°F. The coldest month of the year in Qarshi is **January**, with an average low of 30°F and high of 47°F.



SNOWFALL

The snowy period of the year lasts for 2.1 months, from December 19 to February 23, with a sliding 31-day snowfall of at least 1.0 inches. The month with the most snow in Qarshi is January, with an average snowfall of 1.4 inches.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Based on this score, the best time of year to visit Qarshi for general outdoor tourist activities is from late August to early October, with a peak score in the third week of September.

PRECIPITATION

The wetter season lasts 5.9 months, from November 13 to May 10, with a greater than 11% chance of a given day being a wet day. The month with the most wet days in Qarshi is March, with an average of 6.1 days with at least 0.04 inches of precipitation.

RAINFALL

The rainy period of the year lasts for 6.2 months, from November 9 to May 15, with a sliding 31-day rainfall of at least 0.5 inches. The month with the most rain in Qarshi is March, with an average rainfall of 1.2 inches.

MEDICAL EDUCATION SYSTEM IN UZBEKISTAN

Uzbekistan has a well-structured medical education system that follows international standards while incorporating local healthcare requirements. Medical universities in Uzbekistan offer programs in General Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, and Nursing, with a focus on practical training and clinical exposure.



• 1. Medical Degree Structure

- Medical education in Uzbekistan is primarily divided into the following stages:

-

• Undergraduate (MBBS/MD Equivalent):

- Duration: 5-6 years (including clinical training).
- Language of Instruction: English, Russian, or Uzbek.
- Includes theoretical courses, practical sessions, and hospital internships.

• Postgraduate (Specialization/Residency):

- Duration: 2-5 years (depending on specialization).
- Focuses on advanced clinical training and research.

• Doctorate (PhD in Medical Sciences):

- Duration: 3-5 years.
- Involves extensive research and dissertation work.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR MEDICAL EDUCATION IN UZBEKISTAN FOR UNDERGRADUATE (MBBS/MD) ADMISSION



1. Academic Requirements

- Must have completed high school (12th grade or equivalent) from a recognized board.
- General Category: 50% in PCB
- SC/ST/OBC: 40% – 50% in PCB.
- NEET qualification is mandatory for Indian students applying for MBBS abroad (as per NMC rules).

2. Age Requirement

- The minimum age requirement for MBBS admission in Uzbekistan is 17 years at the time of admission or by December 31 of the admission year.
- There is no strict upper age limit, but some universities may have a maximum age limit of 25–30 years



3. Entrance Exams

- Some universities require an entrance exam or interview.
- If the program is in English, an IELTS/TOEFL score may be required (varies by university).



4. Visa & Other Documents

- 12th-grade Certificate & Marksheet.
- NEET Scorecard (for Indian students).
- Valid Passport
- 15-20 copy passport size photograph
- Hard copy of student visa
- Medical Fitness Certificate
- Travel & Health Insurance

TRAINING OF FOREIGN STUDENTS IN UZBEKISTAN (MEDICAL EDUCATION & CLINICAL TRAINING)

Uzbekistan offers high-quality medical education and clinical training to foreign students, ensuring they gain both theoretical knowledge and hands-on experience in hospitals and research centers.

1. Medical Training System for Foreign Students

Medical education in Uzbekistan follows international standards and includes:

A. Preclinical Training (1st–3rd Year)

- Basic Medical Sciences – Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, etc.
- Laboratory & Practical Training – Conducted in well-equipped medical labs.
- Early Clinical Exposure – Introduction to hospital settings and basic patient care.



B. Clinical Training (4th–6th Year)

- Hospital Rotations – Hands-on experience in affiliated teaching hospitals.
- Core Specialties – Internal Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, Gynecology, Psychiatry, Radiology, etc.
- Patient Interaction & Case Studies – Supervised by experienced doctors.
- Research & Thesis Work – Encouraged in top universities.

2. Internship & Practical Training

- Final Year (6th Year) includes a mandatory internship at affiliated hospitals.

- Students gain real-world experience in diagnosis, treatment, and patient management.
- Clinical training is conducted in government & private hospitals under professional supervision.

3. Recognition & Licensing

- Medical degrees from Uzbekistan are recognized by WHO, FAIMER, and ECFMG, making graduates eligible for licensing exams like USMLE (USA), PLAB (UK), FMGE (India), AMC (Australia), etc.
- After completing MBBS, students can apply for postgraduate studies or medical practice worldwide.

SPORTS

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR TURON UNIVERSITY

Before applying to Turon University the student who desire to get higher education in Uzbekistan are advised to get all the information regarding the various options available in Uzbekistan.

STEP 1: FILLING THE FORM:

An application form is to be filled by the student for applying to Turon University.



- a) Application form
- b) Copy of your passport (pages with the photo, date of birth and passport expiry date);
- c) certificate of complete higher secondary education with academic transcript for undergraduate programs / higher education degree with academic transcript for postgraduate programs.

STEP 2: RECEIVING THE ADMISSION LETTER:

An admission letter will be received from the university after application has been accepted, confirming the reservation of a seat for the student at the university and in certain cases the invoice to remit the fees.



STEP 3: RECEIVING THE VISA:

After confirmation of the admission by the University, the Department of Federal migration service of the Uzbekistan start the process of issuing the official visa for the study" (according to the application submitted by the university) It takes the Department of inter-migration service of the Uzbekistan approximately 35 to 45 days to issue the visa for study.

STEP 4: DEPARTURE TO UZBEKISTAN:

After receiving the visa the student can prepare himself to depart to receive prior to one month from the expiry date. In line with the requirements for higher studies in any foreign country, Uzbekistan has also made it mandatory for international students to get their educational testimonials suitably apostilled and attested in their home country.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS FOR TRAVELING TO UZBEKISTAN

- **Keep Your Documents Safe:** Carry all essential documents securely, including your passport, visa, air ticket, and invitation letter. Keep them in your handbag for easy access.
- **Secure Your Baggage:** Ensure all check-in baggage is locked and labeled with name tags for easy identification.
- **Restricted Items:**
 - Avoid carrying sharp objects, gels, deodorants, or moisturizers in your hand baggage, as they are not allowed.
 - Liquids and medicines should not be carried in hand baggage. If you must carry medicines, ensure you have a valid doctor's prescription.
- **In-Flight Safety:** Listen carefully to the airline crew's safety demonstration upon boarding and follow their instructions.
- **Document Copies:**
 - Carry at least two photocopies of all important documents, including your passport (first and last three pages), visa, air ticket, traveler's cheques, invitation letter, and credit cards.
 - Leave a copy of these documents with family or friends in India for emergencies.
- **Airport Security:** Always keep an eye on your baggage during check-in and check-out at the airport.
- **Respect Local Laws:** Follow all rules and regulations of Uzbekistan to ensure a smooth and trouble-free stay.

1. Important Documents (Keep Originals + 2 Copies):

- Passport (Valid for at least six months)
- Student Visa for Uzbekistan
- University Admission Letter
- Air Ticket
- Travel & Health Insurance
- NEET Scorecard
- 10th & 12th Mark Sheets & Certificates
- Medical Certificate & HIV Test Report (As per Uzbekistan's requirement)
- Apostilled & Attested Educational Documents

2. Essential Medicines & Health Supplies:

- Basic Medicines (Painkillers, cold & flu medicine, stomach relief, allergy medication, etc.)
- Doctor's Prescription (For any prescribed medication)
- Thermometer & First Aid Kit
- Face Masks & Hand Sanitizer
- Personal Hygiene Products (Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, etc.)

3. Academic Essentials:

- Stethoscope & Lab Coat
- Medical Books & Notebooks
- Laptop & Charger
- USB Drive & External Hard Disk
- Scientific Calculator & Stationery (Pens, notebooks, highlighters, sticky notes)

4. Electronic Gadgets & Accessories:

- International Power Adapter (Uzbekistan uses Type C & F plugs)
- Mobile Phone & Charger
- Power Bank (For charging on the go)
- Headphones/Earphones (For online classes or entertainment)

5. Miscellaneous Items:

- Umbrella & Raincoat (For unpredictable weather)
- Small Backpack/Handbag (For daily use)
- Lock & Key (For securing personal belongings in the hostel)
- Laundry Bag & Detergent
- Basic Sewing Kit (For minor clothing repairs)
- Notebook/Diary (For jotting down important university information)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Studying MBBS Abroad

Q1: Is MBBS abroad a good option for Indian students?

✓ Yes, it is affordable, has good infrastructure, and offers globally recognized degrees.

Q2: Is an MBBS degree from abroad valid in India?

✓ Yes, if the university is NMC-approved. Students must clear FMGE/NEXT to practice in India.

Q3: Which countries are best for MBBS abroad?

✓ Russia, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, China, Georgia, and the Philippines.

Q4: What is the duration of MBBS abroad?

✓ Usually 5-6 years, depending on the country.

Q5: Is NEET mandatory for MBBS abroad?

✓ Yes, NEET qualification is required for Indian students.

Q6: What are the eligibility criteria?

✓ 50% in PCB (40% for reserved categories) in 12th grade + NEET qualification.

Q7: What documents are required for admission?

✓ Passport, 10th & 12th Mark Sheets, NEET Scorecard, Medical Certificate, Admission Letter, Visa.

Q8: Is there an entrance exam for MBBS abroad?

✓ No, most universities do not require an entrance exam.

Q9: What is the cost of MBBS abroad?

✓ \$3,000 to \$7,000 per year (varies by country).

Q10: What are the living expenses abroad?

✓ \$200 to \$500 per month, depending on the country.

Q11: Are scholarships available for MBBS abroad?

✓ Yes, some universities and governments offer scholarships.

Q12: Where do students stay?

✓ University hostels, private apartments, or shared PG accommodations.

Q13: Is Indian food available abroad?

✓ Yes, many universities have Indian mess facilities, and Indian grocery stores are available.

Q14: Is it safe to study MBBS abroad?

✓ Yes, most countries have student-friendly environments and good security.

Q15: Can I work while studying MBBS abroad?

✓ No, most countries do not allow medical students to work.

Q16: What is FMGE/NEXT, and why is it important?

✓ It is a licensing exam for foreign medical graduates to practice in India.

Q17: Can I do PG after MBBS abroad?

✓ Yes, in India (via NEET-PG/NEXT) or in countries like the USA, UK, or Germany.

Q18: Can I practice in India after MBBS abroad?

✓ Yes, but you must pass the FMGE/NEXT exam and complete a 1-year internship.

Q19: How long does it take to get a student visa?

✓ 30-45 days, depending on the country.

Q20: Can I visit India during vacations?

✓ Yes, students can travel home during semester breaks.
